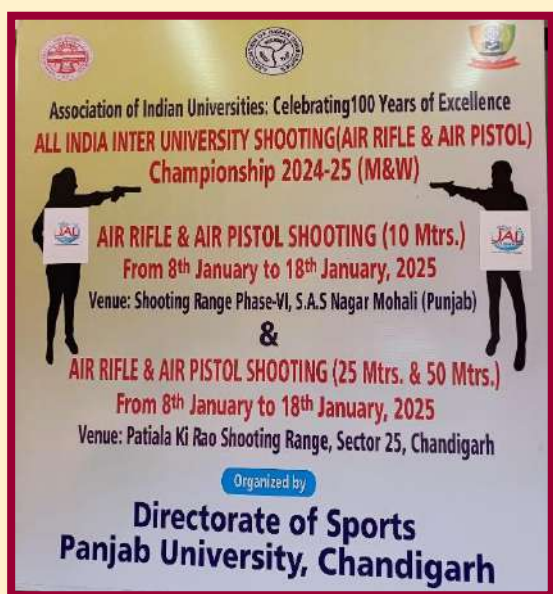
POST-EVENT DETAILS:-

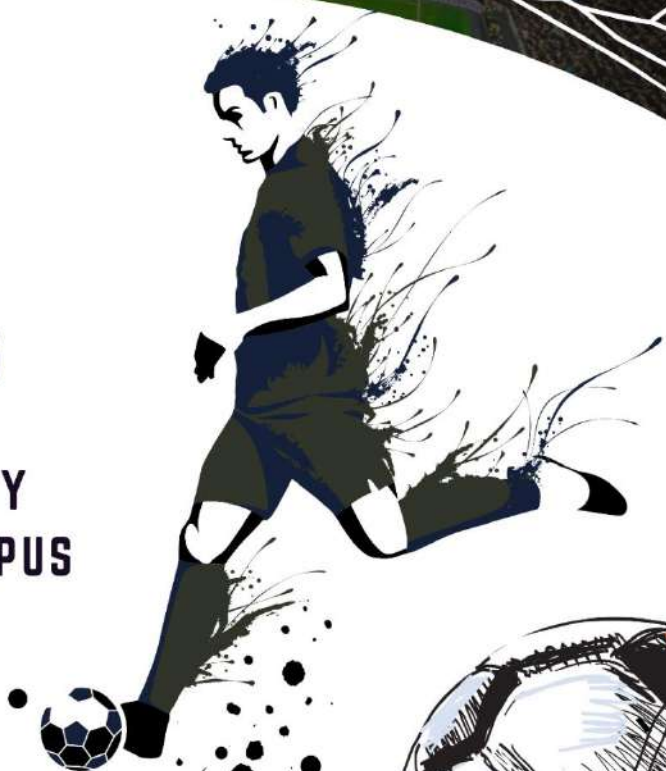

TEAM COMPOSITION:-

MATCH SUMMARY:-

Day 1: Match against RVITM

Our first match was against RV College, and it proved to be a tough challenge. The primary issue we faced was adjusting to a 9-a-side football court, which was significantly different from the smaller courts we were accustomed to. While we had individually talented players, the lack of regular practice and structured guidance was evident. Additionally, maintaining fitness for the full 50-minute game was difficult, as our training had not prepared us for this format.

Day 2: Match against DOC MAHE

On the second day, we played against DOC MAHE College. The match started well, but after the 10th minute, we struggled to keep up with the opponents' pace. This led to a significant score gap in their favour. One of the key challenges we faced was the lack of team chemistry, as we had played together as a team only once before the tournament.

CHALLENGES FACED:-

- 1. Lack of Familiarity with 9-A-Side Format:** Our team had limited experience playing on a 9-a-side court, affecting our positioning and strategy.
- 2. Fitness Levels:** Due to the larger playing area, endurance and stamina were crucial, but we struggled to maintain energy throughout the match.
- 3. Opponent Experience:** While the teams we faced were not necessarily the strongest, their regular practice and familiarity with proper football courts gave them an advantage.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:-

- 1. Regular Practice Sessions:** To improve our performance in future, we need consistent training sessions focused on both individual and team gameplay.
- 2. Strategic Gameplay:** Understanding different game formats and developing tactical awareness will help us adapt better to various playing conditions.
- 3. Team Coordination:** More practice matches should be conducted to build better on-field chemistry and communication among players.

We are grateful to our college for providing us with this opportunity and look forward to representing our institution in future events. With the right training, guidance, and commitment, we are confident that our team has the potential to achieve great results in upcoming tournaments.

However, the match highlighted certain areas that need improvement:

- Missed passes and lack of court coordination disrupted the offensive play.
- Defensive efforts, although spirited, fell short in key moments due to inability to read fake passes and opponent's swift movements.
- The team displayed strong effort and composure under pressure, keeping the score line close against a well-practiced opponent.

CHALLENGES FACED

- Lack of on-court communication led to confusion during fast plays and transitions.
- Defensive lapses, especially in marking players and intercepting passes, allowed the opponents to maintain a narrow lead.
- Playing against an experienced and well-coordinated host team required quicker decision-making and more structured strategies.

LEARNINGS FROM THE TOURNAMENT

- Importance of coordination and communication among players during high-paced games.
